

\$29.6 Million for Chicago Metra Crash Passenger

A Cook County jury awarded a record \$29.6 million to a passenger who suffered a traumatic brain injury when a Chicago Metra train crashed and derailed after entering a track crossover at 69 miles per hour (mph) instead of the posted 10 mph. Corboy & Demetrio Chicago personal injury lawyers, Thomas Demetrio, Daniel Kotin and William Gibbs, represented the passenger in the two-week jury trial. The verdict is the largest in Illinois for an individual injured in a mass transit crash.
